Moises receives physical therapy and speech therapy which have improved his motor skills and his concentration. The goal is to have him attend regular school in the fall. As with each child in the group home, Moises has blossomed in the skills that he has acquired and he now knows the joy of the Lord and having the group home and church family to love him.
